### Our Mission:

**To improve the individual skill level and hockey sense of each female player in New Zealand and further develop woman's ice hockey across the country.**

The focus for these two-day development camps are the further acquisition and improvement of fundamental individual hockey skills including skating, passing & receiving, pick handling, shooting & scoring as well as individual tactics and developing hockey sense.

Players will participate in 4 x 1 hour on-ice training sessions. Each ice session will include work on basic skills and game situations.

As well, each day will include off-ice sessions working on further individual skill development, fitness work, games and instruction.

- ❑ Target Age: 13 years to senior in the 2010 season
- ❑ Limited to 30 players per camp
- ❑ Total of 4 hours on-ice time
- ❑ On-ice practice jersey for the weekend
- ❑ Fitness and off-ice skills training daily
- ❑ Small Area Games each ice session
- ❑ Personal evaluation report after the weekend including skills testing
- ❑ Personal NZIHF certificate after the weekend

**Total all-inclusive cost \$120.00**

All participants are expected to be fully equipped with all safety gear, including full-face protection, throat protector as well as having a named water bottle. Players are expected to be at the rink, ready for off-ice warm up 45 minutes before each ice session.

Registrations are open to all female players 13 years of age and older in New Zealand on a first in, first served basis. The NZIHF reserves the right to decline any applications.

To receive top priority, your registration form must be received accompanied by a \$50 non-refundable deposit cheque. Please Note to make all cheques payable to: The New Zealand Ice Hockey Federation.

Confirmation of acceptance to the camp will be emailed to you upon receipt of your Registration Form. The balance of the \$120 Registration Fee is due before the first ice session. Distribution of practice jerseys will take place then.

CHRISTCHURCH CAMP – December 4 – 5 at ALPINE ICE:  
Saturday 12:30-1:30pm & 10:15-11:15pm  
Sunday 8:30-9:30am & 12:30-1:30pm

It is expected that all 2011 NZ Ice Fernz players attend the camp in their region both for their personal growth and for the development of the Women's game in New Zealand.
